Introduction:

Has 3 parts, your question, background and hypothesis

Methodology:

3 sections with sufficient detail so that someone else could repeat your research

Materials, procedures, statistical tests if appropriate.

You can also include pictures of your set up here

Title and Authors

Abstract:

brief overview of the entire lab including main results (claim)

Results:

Describe results clearly – include data tables, graphs, pictures etc

Discussion:

What do your results mean when you consider your original question?
Point out the significance (CEE)
Discuss any errors
Attempt to explain WHY results happened (concept connections). Point out any possible further research

Literature Cited:

Use APA citations for all work references in your poster or lab documents that you used. Our AP Lab manual is from the college board. Can continue on the back if needed
